

Education Program

An educational and vocational program offered to rural county jails that currently do not have an education program or need to supplement their program.

Utilizing the Essential Education learning platform, presently used by the Department of Corrections and the Department of Human Resources, provides students the opportunity to complete TABE Testing, GED Academy, learn Computer and Work Skills, receive tutoring, and partake in College Education opportunities, which include the Coperr Program for work release students.

Reusable License

Each jail can request as many seats or licenses as they need. Once an inmate has been transferred or released, that seat is available to the next inmate.

For inmates transferring to DOC, all progress through the Essential Education transfers with them.

Laptops

Each laptop is white-boarded to ensure safety and security. Laptops with Wi-Fi capability are programmed to only allow access to the Essential Education website.

Laptops without Wi-Fi capability are pre-programmed with the Essential Education curriculum.
